



Hello Class 3!


How are you all? I want you to know that I am missing you all so much and I'm so proud of all the learning you are doing at home.

Today, we are going to start off with a song. This is one of my favourite songs. I hope you like it too.



How was your day at school Mark asked Mum.




Challenge: Turn this comic strip into a piece of text using direct speech.
