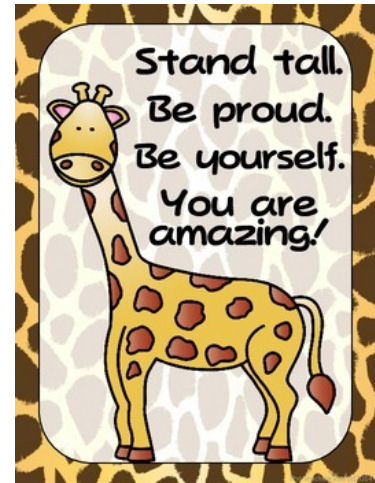


Monday 15th June 2020
