So far this week, we have focused on temperature. Today, we are now going to think about weight.

Weight- How heavy something is.

Do you remember what equipment we use to measure weight?





That's right! We use measuring scales to measure weight!

Do you remember what units we use to measure weight?

We measure weight in grams (g) and kilograms (kg).

Remember, there are 1000 grams (g) in a kilogram (kg).

Your kitchen might be a good place to start! Often packages have the weight written on, for example this is my pack of pasta.




Can you find items as close to the weights below as possible?

Our last lesson today, is a bit of reading




