Sharing

We would say:

12 sweets shared between 3 people gives 4 sweets each.

The answer lies in the value of each equal share.

Grouping

Lucy has 12 sweets. She wants to put them into bags of 3. How many bags will she have?










Ne would say:

12 sweets put into bags (groups) of 3 gives 4 bags (groups).


The answer lies in the number of equal groups.

5a. Write a word story and the division calculation to match the image below.




Our next lesson is English.

Great work today Class 3. Did you learn your poem yesterday too? Keep practising and keep an eye out for some questions to check!


