We are looking forward to seeing or hearing about what you do today.




She has loved this, but still doesn't quite understand where she can hide. Could you write a sentence to tell her where he is hiding?</p> <p>You will need to use some special words called 'prepositions' in your sentences. A preposition tells you the position of something.
