Punctuation Rule


Add apostrophe + s ('s) to the end of singular compound nouns with hyphens to make them possessive (show ownership): editor-in-chief's desk.

A **compound noun** is made up of two or three words. Sometimes the words are combined into one word: scare + crow = scarecrow. Sometimes they stay as two separate words: $school\ bus$. Sometimes the words are connected by hyphens: editor-in-chief. When the compound noun is hyphenated, follow the rule above.




Challenge — can you think of 4 of your own for your family?
