Numeracy $\quad$ Today we are going to practise our times tables.

Remember ' $x$ ' means 'lots of.' So, $2 \times 5$ is the same as 2 lots of 5 .

Here are 2 lots of 5 . They make 10 altogether. We can write it as $2 \times 5=10$


First, I would like you to practise your 2,5, and 10 times tables on Times Table Rockstar's.

Then see how many you can remember by writing them down. Start with your $2 x$ tables first.

Here are mine, I couldn't remember them all. Do you think you can beat me?

| $2 \times$ | $5 \times$ | $10 x$ |
| :---: | :--- | :---: |
| $1 \times 2: 2$ | $1 \times 5=5$ | $1 \times 10=10$ |
