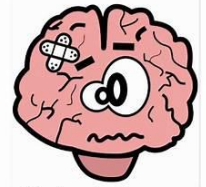
First up, we are going to start with maths. We are going to look at equivalent lengths. What measurements are the arrows pointing to?

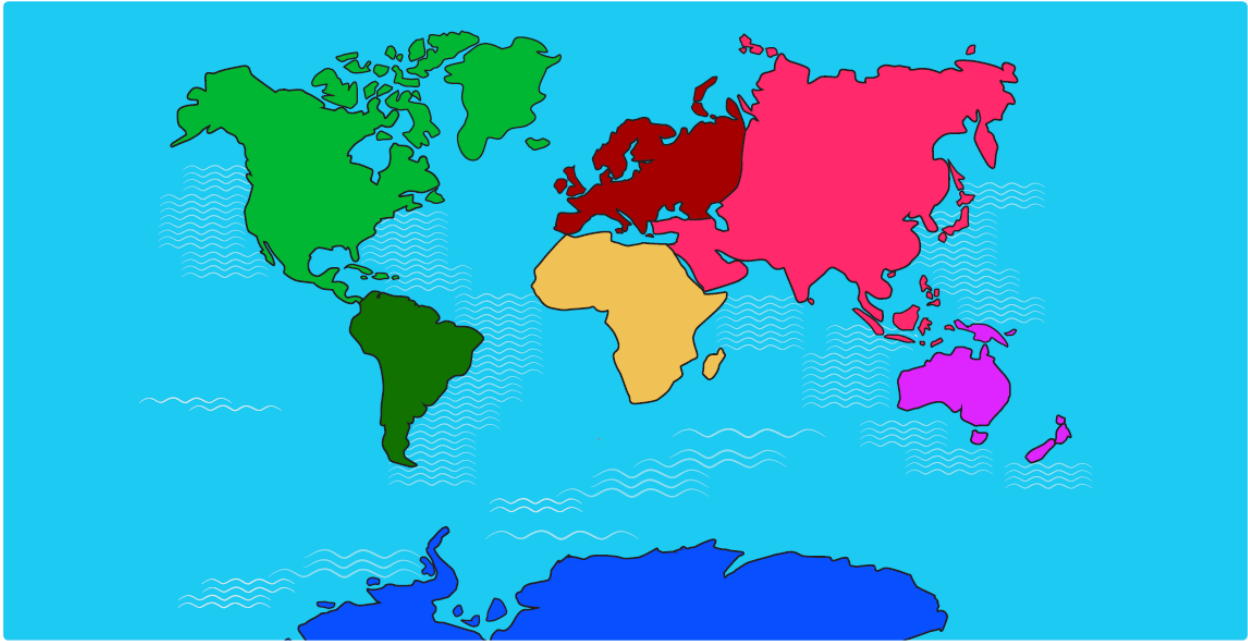
Our last lesson is geography.
