Maths and Funky Fingers - What's Your Score?

You will need :



1. Some paper (old letters and magazines are perfect!)



2. Some tape



3. Scissors



4. A pencil or pen

Ask an adult to help you to cut a piece of paper into 3 strips. Write a number on each strip. Begin with numbers 1,2 and 3. Bend and stick the strips onto the floor to make goals. Scrunch up another piece of paper into a small ball. Take turns to flick and shoot.



Make marks to keep your score.



This is a great way to practise counting.

Challenge

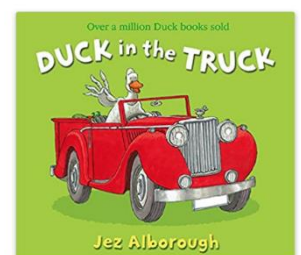
Use higher numbers for each goal.

Who tried to help the duck get out of the muck?

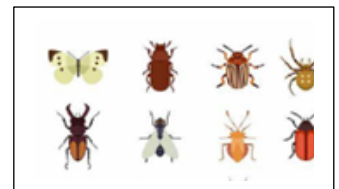
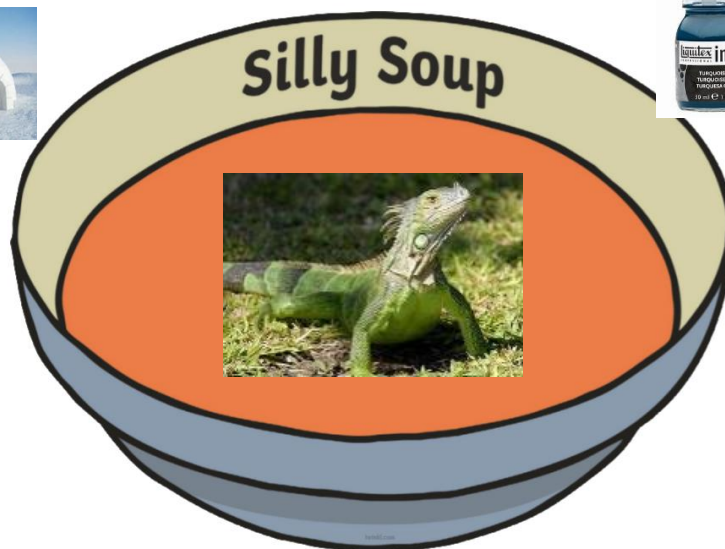
Build a Truck
