A huge thumbs up to you all!




Number Time - Roll a dice duck game



Play this game with a family member. You will need some play dough, a dice and something to use as feathers - sticks or leaves make great feathers. Make a play dough duck each. You will both need handful of feathers - make sure you have the amount. Take it in turns to roll the dice. Count the dots. Then, count out the correct number of feathers and add them to your duck. Whoever puts all of their feathers on the duck first is the winner!



Yesterday we read *One Duck Got Stuck*. There were some unusual animals in the story.



This is a moose. This is the size of a moose next to a man. They are pretty huge! They live in forests near lakes and rivers and eat plants like leaves, tree bark and underwater plants. Every year the male moose grows huge antlers on his head. I think they look like enormous, woody hands.
