Don't forget that you need to use your ISPACE openers and you will need to use a range of punctuation.

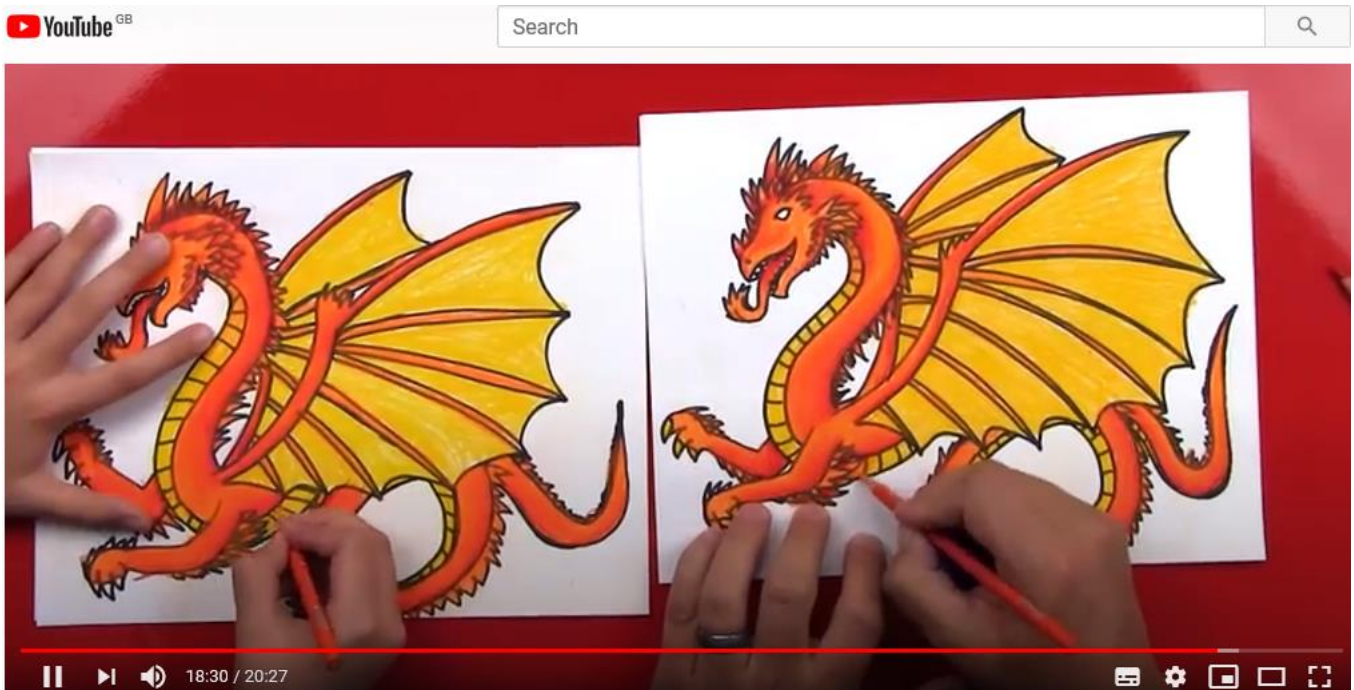
Don't forget to use a **comma** after your ISPACE sentence starter.
