

Dice Cricket

A game for two players.

You will need 1 dice.

- Decide who will be Team A and who will be Team B.
- Make up names for your players and write them in the grid.
- Team A plays first.
- Throw the dice for player 1.
- Dook at the scoring grid to see what player 1 scored and write it in the grid where it says '1st ball'.
- Throw again for his second ball unless he was out.
- If he is out on any ball, then Team A continues with their second player, and so on until all the team have had a turn. Each player has a maximum of 4 balls.
- Team B then take their turn in the same way.
- Each team adds up all their players' totals to see which team has won.




