You could make some cakes or biscuits with an adult. Here as a simple biscuit recipe. You can make any shape you want and decorate them as you wish.



### Star Biscuits

#### Ingredients

100g butter  
50g caster sugar  
175g plain flour  
A few drops of vanilla extract

#### Equipment

Bowl  
Spoon  
Rolling pin  
Star cookie cutter  
Baking tray

#### Method

1. Preheat the oven to 150°C.
2. Add butter and sugar in a bowl and mix well until light and fluffy.
3. Add the vanilla, mix, then add the flour and mix well.
4. Roll out to about 5mm thick. Cut into star shapes.
5. Bake for 25 minutes or until golden brown.
