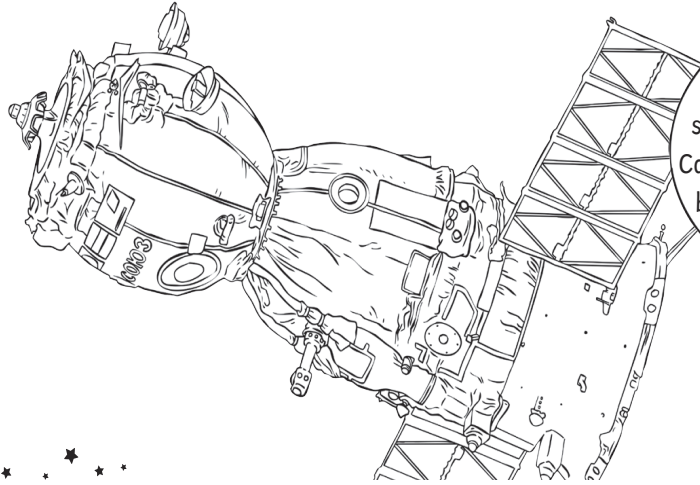

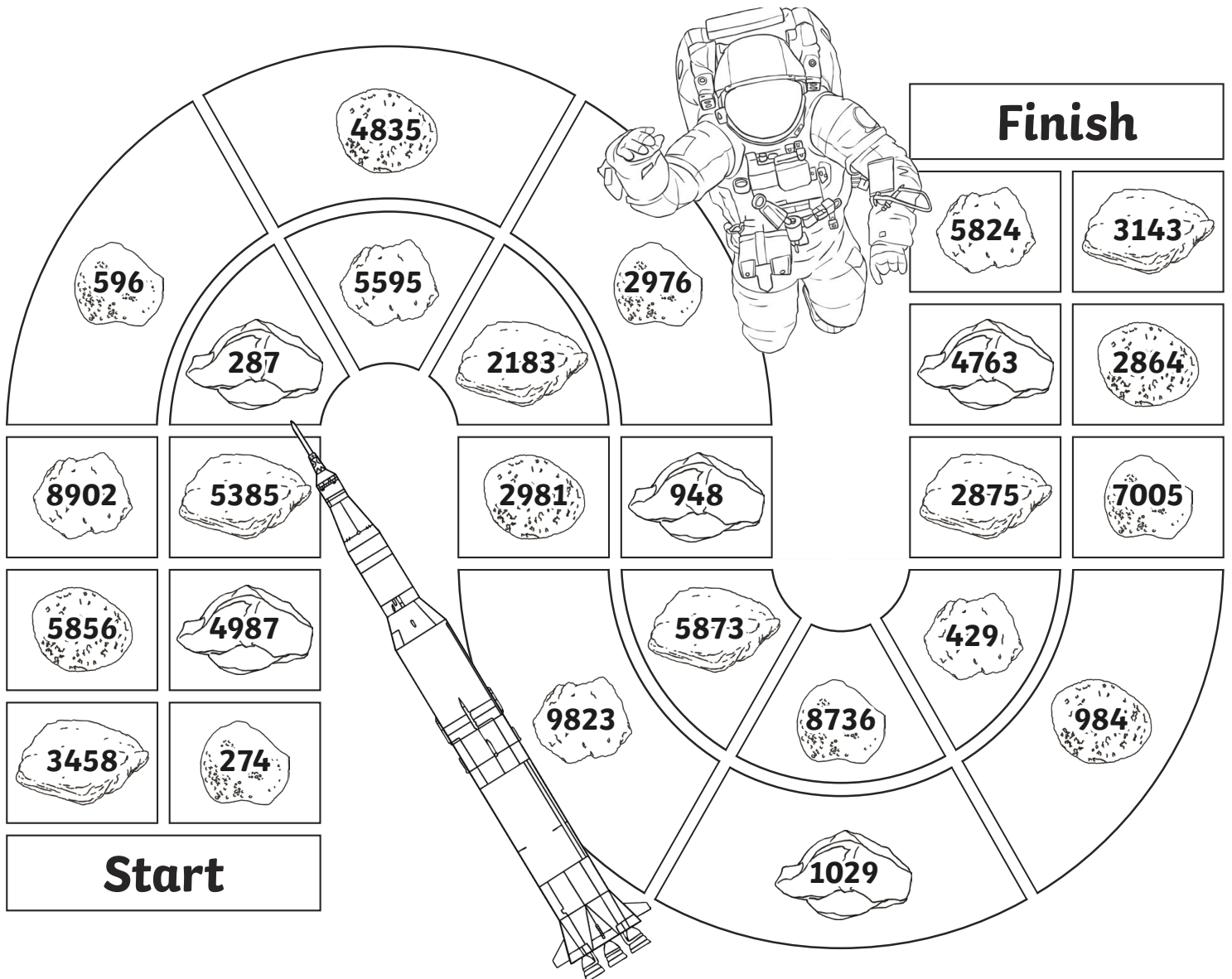
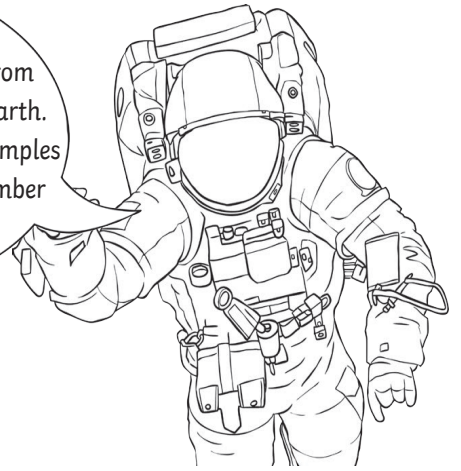


Instructions

Hello there! I am on a mission to collect samples from some of the planets beyond Earth. Can you help me collect the samples by rounding each sample number to the nearest 10?

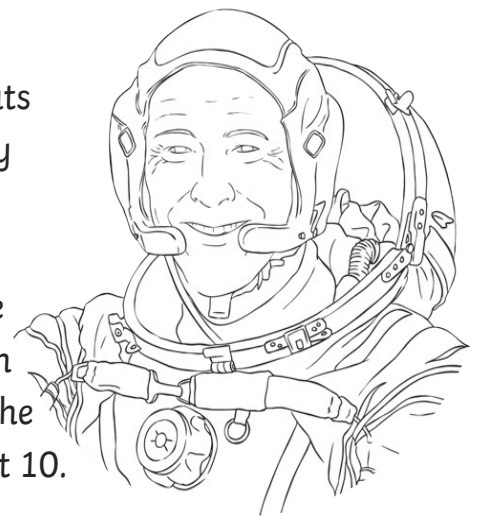




Interesting Fact
