Can you help me? I am trying to write some sentences, but I keep spelling some words wrong. Look at this sentence. Can you write it so all the words are spelt correctly.

Can you count the smarties? How many are there? Share out the smarties between the two plates. How many smarties does each plate have? By sharing the smarties, you have found half of 10 .
