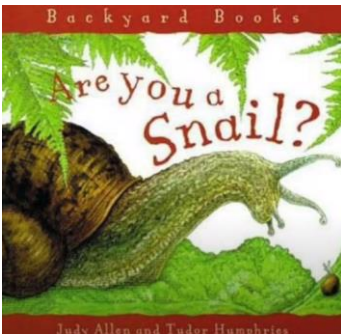

Can you have a go at drawing a spiral pattern. Start in the middle and get bigger and bigger. How big can you make your spiral?

Once you have mastered the skill of drawing a spiral You can now make a spiral dangler.

Can you follow these instructions?

- 1) Get a paper circle.
- 2) Draw a spiral.
- 3) Colour and decorate it.
- 4) Cut on top of your spiral line from the outside to the middle.
- 5) Let your spiral dangle.

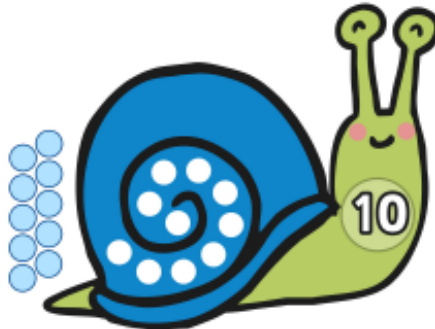
## Number
