

If you find this a little tricky, why not write some 'what is...' questions:


What is your favourite food? What is your favourite song?

Today, your maths mission is to help to feed Ali the Hungry Alligator.




Ali the alligator is always hungry.

Here are some of the things Ali has eaten in the past. Can you see, he always eats the bigger number?




Your mission today is to find objects in your house that Ali can eat, then draw or send us pictures of his snacks.




