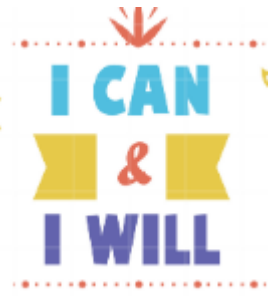




Good Morning Year 3

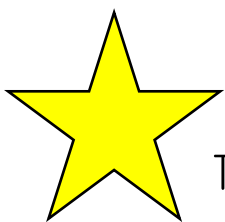

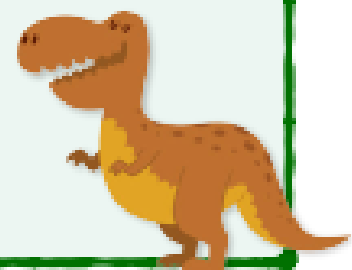

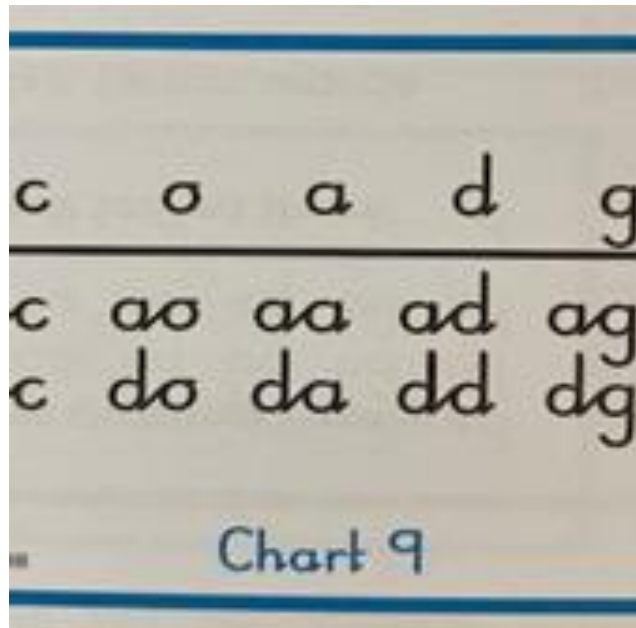
What do you call a dinosaur who always uses boring words?
