How are you today? I loved reading your astronaut applications yesterday, you are all so talented!


Would you like to be an astronaut when you are older?

Will you help make an Earth fact file for this alien?!


You can present it in any way you would like, you might even like to use the computer. You might like to include answers to these questions, you should remember some of the answers from Geography.
