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Good morning Class 4!



Friday today! Our last day of home learning for this week before your weekend begins. I hope you all have a wonderful weekend.

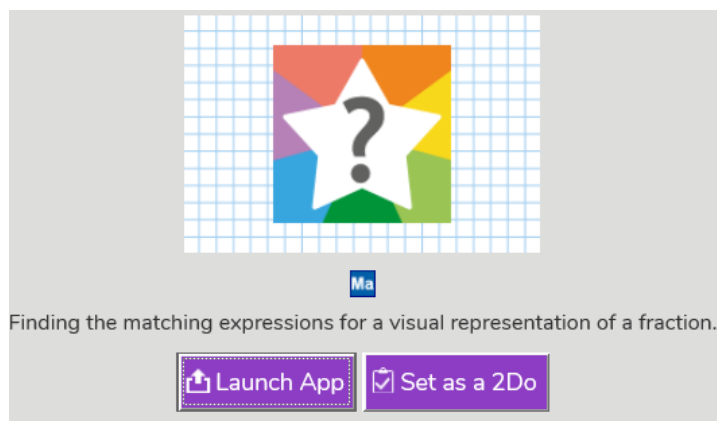
