

Don't forget to enjoy some reading today, practise your challenges and most of all, enjoy some time outside in the fresh air.

In **summer**, the weather is much warmer.

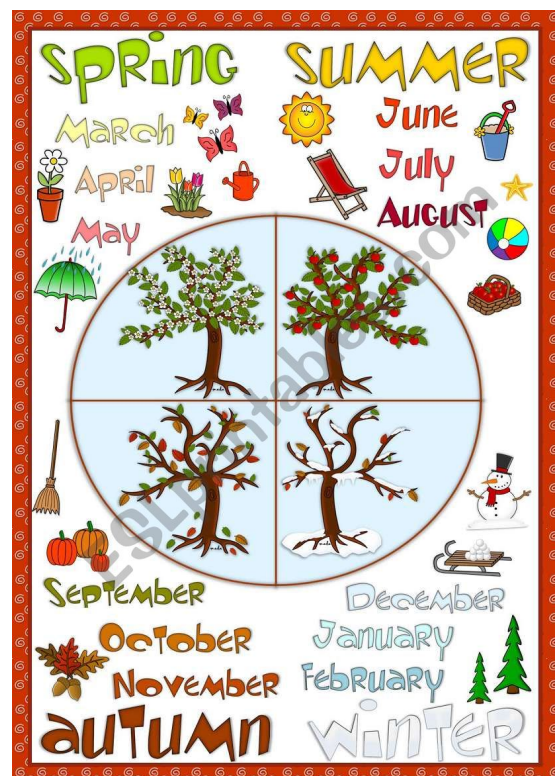
In **autumn**, the leaves fall off the trees.
