the alien ship flew at the speed of light.

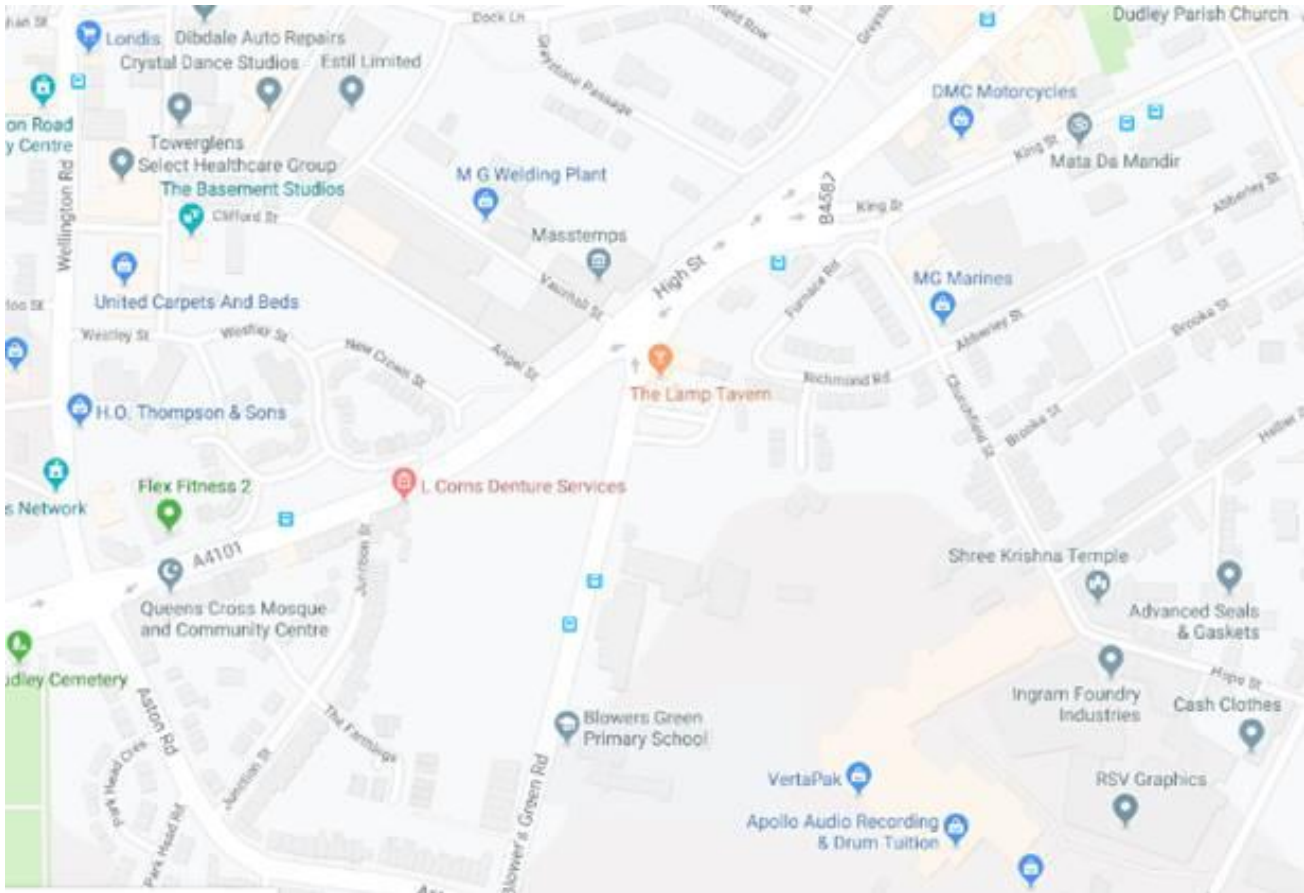
Challenge!
