Watch this BBC video about Pablo Picasso. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/zdfgkqt Look at Picasso's paintings (see below) and choose one to describe: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• What shapes can you see?• What colours can you see?• How does it make you feel?• What is the painting of? What can you see? CHALLENGE: How are the paintings different? How are the paintings the same? Example: <i>The picture of the seated woman uses blue and this makes me feel sad. The lady resting on her elbows uses bright colours and this makes me feel happy. Picasso included different shapes and colours in the painting of...</i>

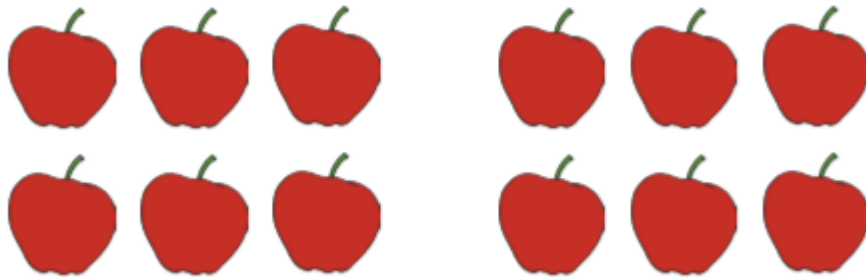
Seated Woman Resting on Elbows (1939)



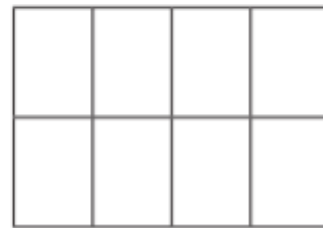
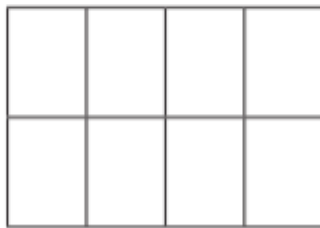
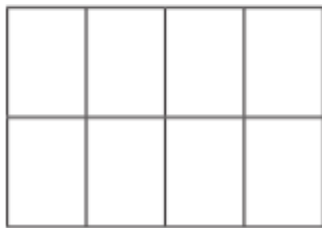

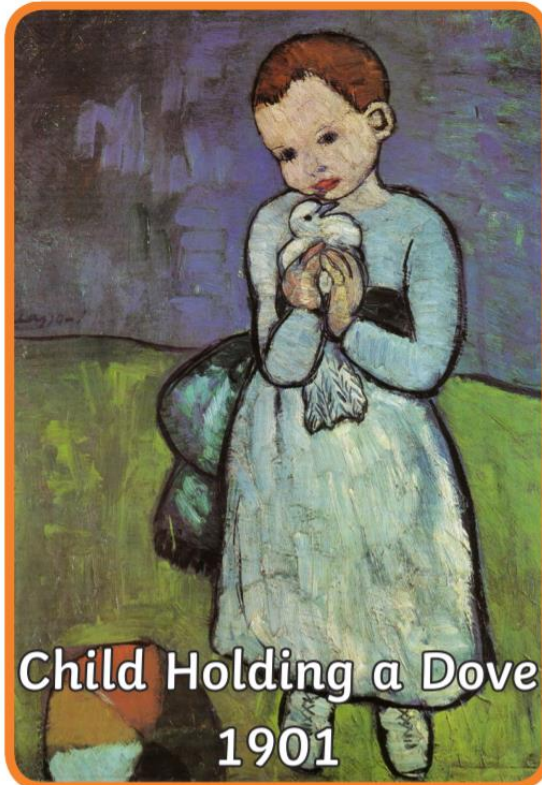

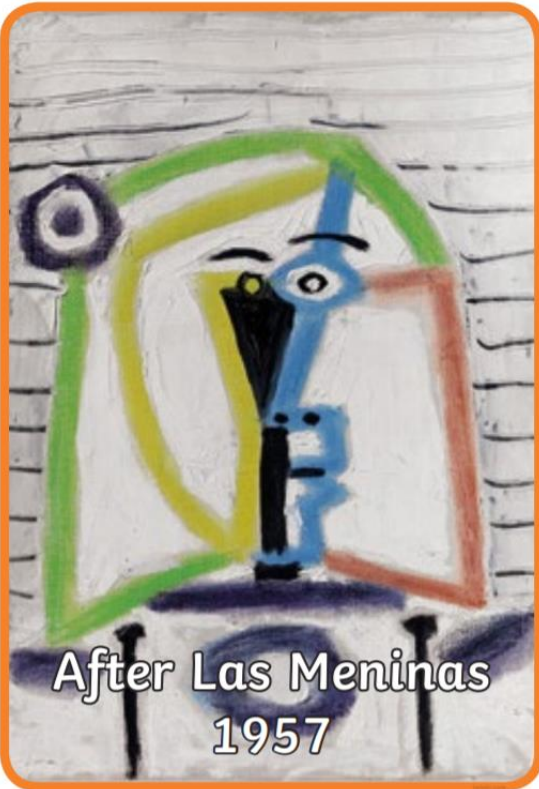

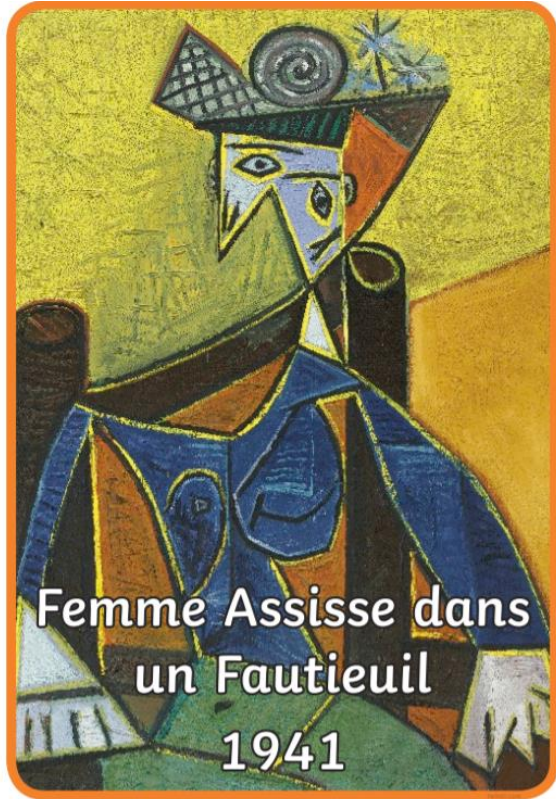

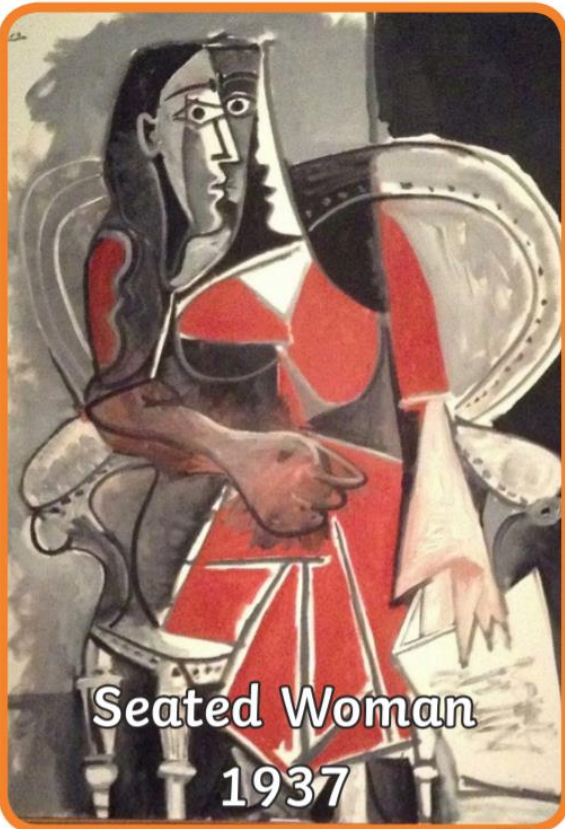
