



Literacy	<p>Read a storybook to your adult.</p> <p>Think about the different settings in the story.</p>	<p>A story setting is where a story takes place. The setting could be a school, home, a castle or zoo.</p> <p>Describe one of the settings in the story to an adult or draw a picture or write a description of the setting.</p> 
Numeracy	<p>Subtraction using a number line.</p>	<p>Use number line to answer these on paper or in your Home Learning book (the green ones are trickier).</p> <p>Remember to start on the first number in the number sentence, then count back. So for 14 - 5, start on 14 and count (jump) back 5.</p>
