You could dress up and act like your character, take a photo and send it to me. You could draw or paint a picture of your favourite character. Maybe you want to create your favourite character on Purple Mash. It is up to you!</p> <p>Once you have drawn/painted/created your character tell me in a couple of sentences why you have chosen this character as your favourite.</p> <p>My favourite book character is Tweedledee from Alice in Wonderland, written by Lewis Carroll in 1865. I have chosen this character because he is always happy and likes to make jokes.</p>
