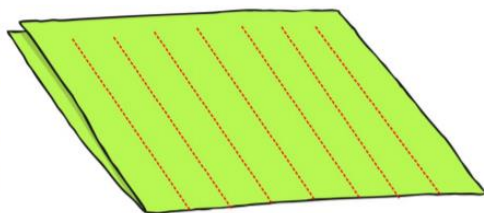
# Weave Paper



### Materials and equipment:

Scissors  
Glue stick  
Pencil  
Coloured paper  
Sticky tape

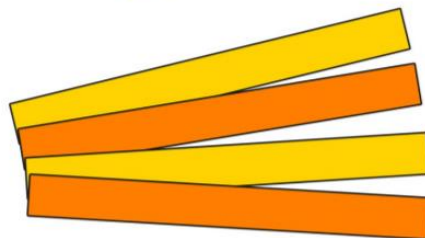
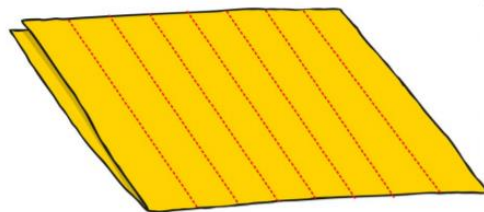

First, fold a piece of paper in half and cut slices into it.

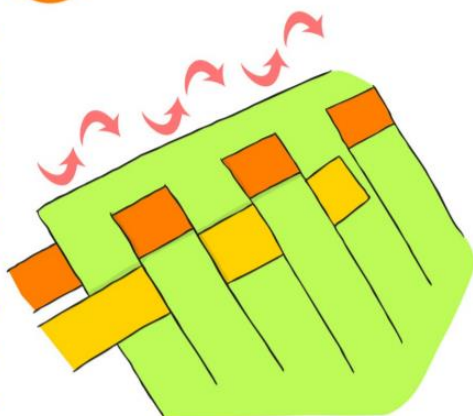
Be careful not to cut all the way through it and leave about an inch of the edge.

Next, cut complete strips of the same width from a second piece of paper.  
Use 2 colours of paper if you wish.

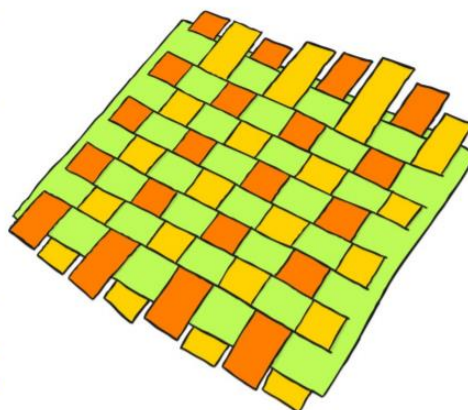

Now thread the strips into the piece of paper you have sliced, by weaving in and out.

Do this until your whole piece of paper has been weaved.

Glue or tape the edges so that the strips of paper don't slip out.

You can try using your woven paper to decorate cards or even diaries and notebooks!



Please continue to regularly read at home.

Remember, reading **to** your child is as important as listening to them read to you!

If you read a particularly good book, it would be great if you could write a short book review about it to recommend it to your classmates! Here's some questions you could answer about it:

What was the book about?

What was your favourite bit?

Who was your favourite character?
