It is a fun reminder that we must keep 2m apart from people who don't live with us when we are out and about so don't forget!

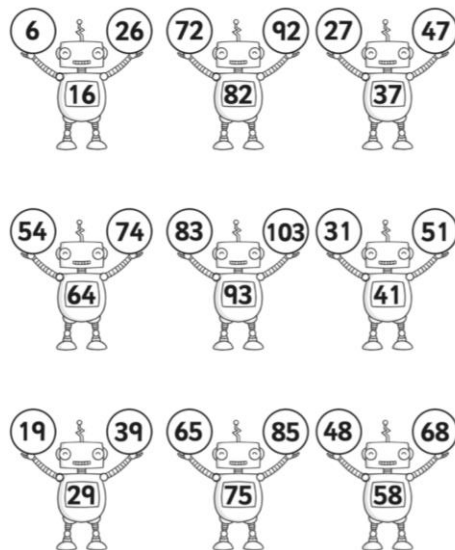
If you would like to try and find Wally in a crowded area like the books, I have attached some pictures at the end of your tasks.

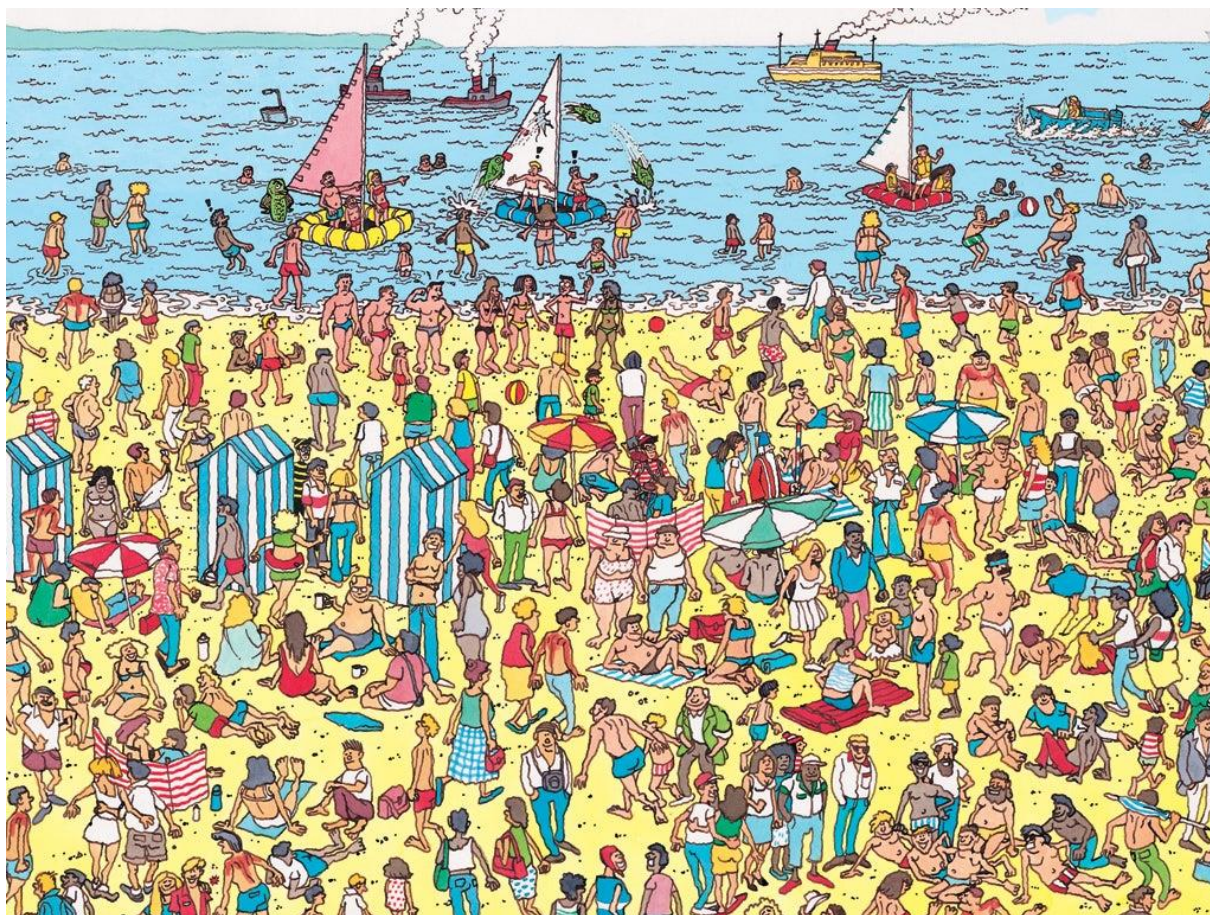
Look at these two pictures. The first picture is an artist impression of what the hospital was like before Florence arrived and the second is after her work at the hospital. Write down what important changes you can see.
