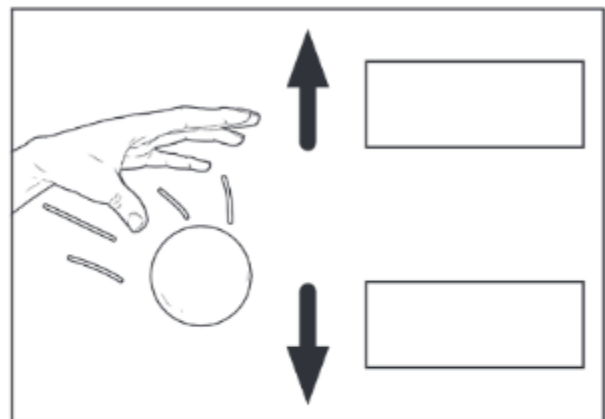
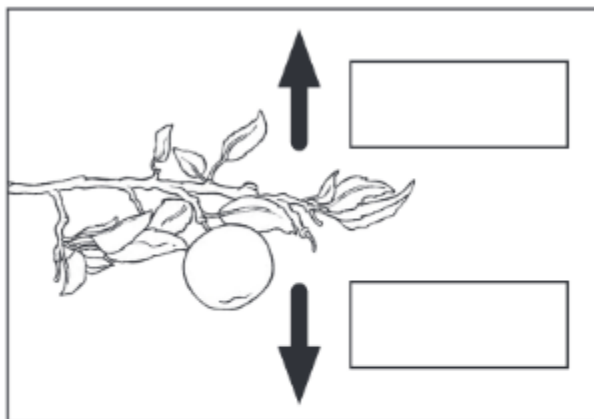
## Science

In autumn we learned about different forces. Complete draw and label the diagrams below. If drawing the images is too difficult you could just write the names of the forces.

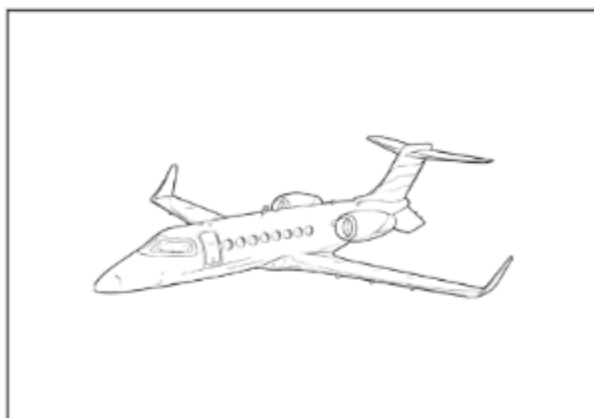
For example: a). air resistance
