Marlon has a football.

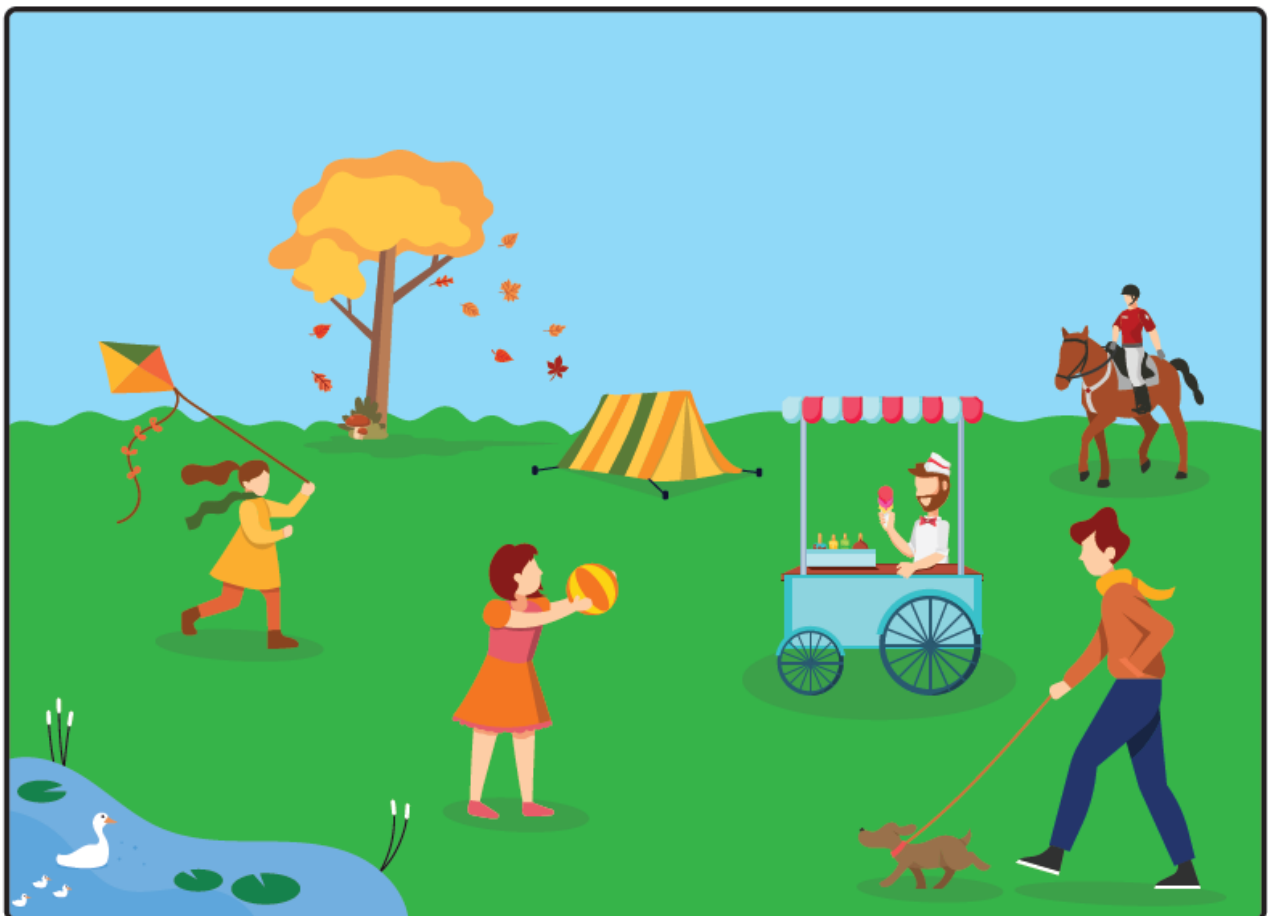
You could say:

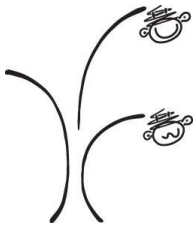
It is Marlon's football.
