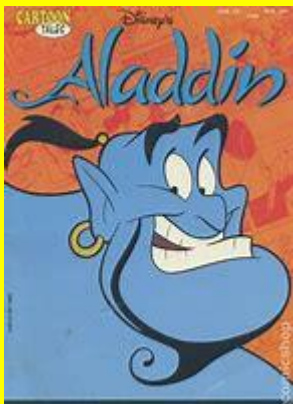

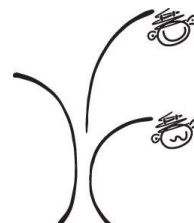

Be the Teacher!

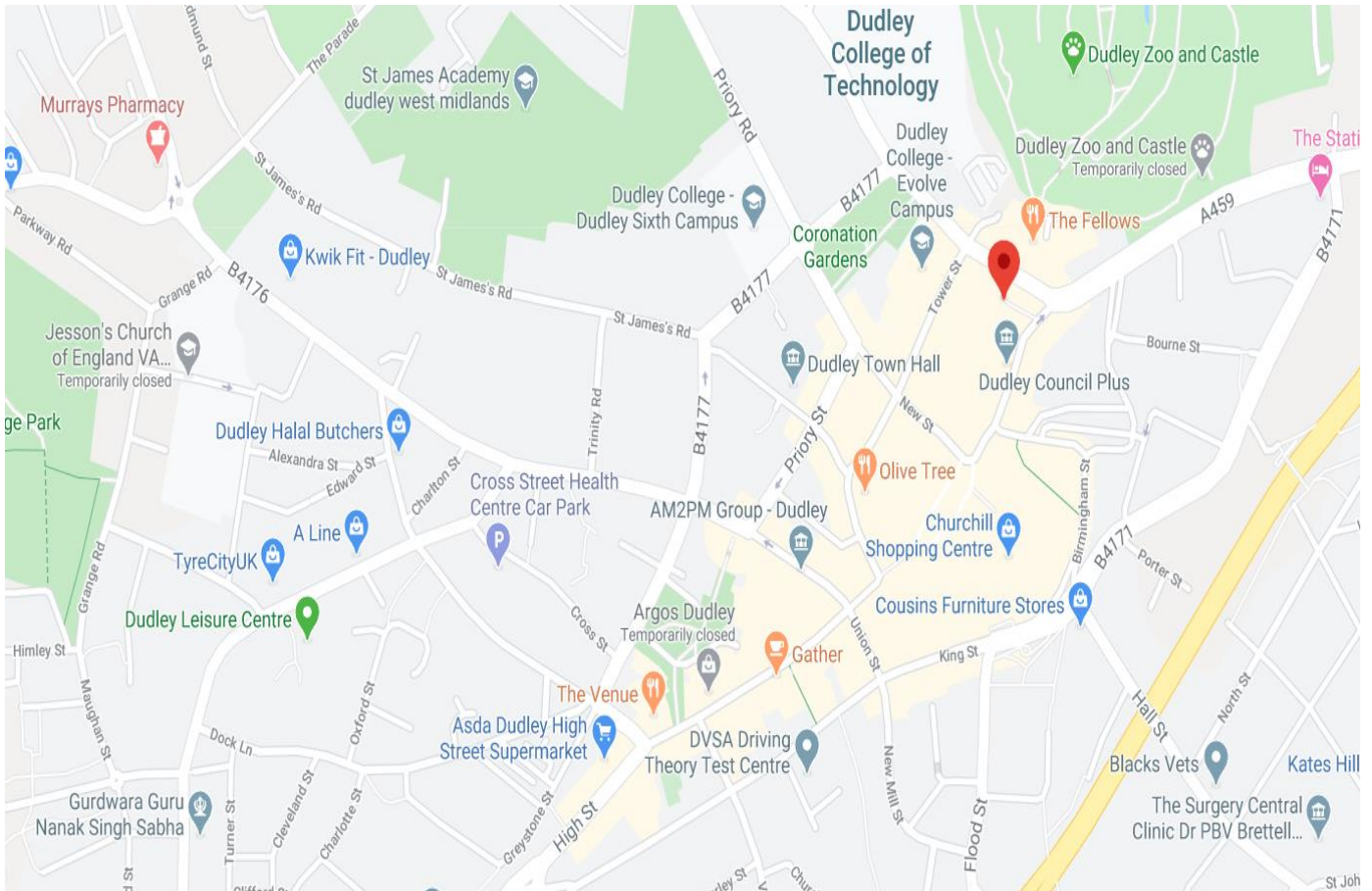

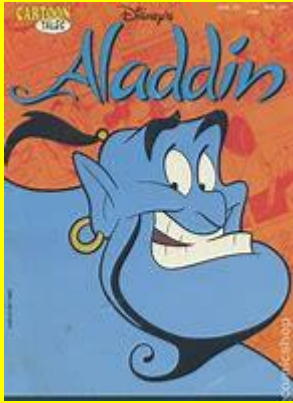



Be the Teacher!
