The next lesson is maths.

Yesterday, you looked at finding unit fractions of an amount. Today I would like you to continue with this and answer these word problems.

Please choose a chilli challenge below. Remember to read the questions carefully so that you know what it is asking you to do and then write your answers into your books.

1. In a bag of marbles, there are 12 marbles.  $\frac{1}{2}$  are blue. How many blue marbles are there?
2. On a bus there are 16 passengers.  $\frac{1}{2}$  are children. How many children are there?
3. I win £9 on the lottery, but give  $\frac{1}{3}$  away - how much do I give away?
4. In the classroom there are 15 children.  $\frac{1}{3}$  like maths. How many children like maths?
5. I threw away 20 Kg of rubbish, but recycled  $\frac{1}{4}$  of it. How much rubbish did I recycle?

1. In a bag of marbles, there are 28 marbles.  $\frac{1}{2}$  are blue. How many blue marbles are there?
2. On a bus there are 36 passengers.  $\frac{1}{2}$  are children. How many children are there?
3. I win £15 on the lottery, but give  $\frac{1}{3}$  away - how much do I give away?
4. In the classroom there are 24 children.  $\frac{1}{3}$  like maths. How many children like maths?
5. I threw away 40 Kg of rubbish, but recycled  $\frac{1}{4}$  of it. How much rubbish did I recycle?

1. In a bag of marbles, there are 100 marbles. Half of them are blue. How many are blue?
2. On a bus, there are 48 passengers. One quarter of them are children. How many children are there?
3. I win £36 on the lottery, but I give away one third. How much do I give away?
4. In Class 3 there are 30 children. One third like maths. How many children don't like maths?
5. I had 72KG of rubbish but I could recycle  $\frac{1}{8}$ . How much did I recycle?

Challenge — I have £45. I spend  $\frac{1}{5}$  on a new football. How much do I have left?
