Happy Monday Year 3! How was your weekend? This weekend George and Harry have been digging up worms in the garden. You know how much they like worms! I hope that you are ready to do some super work and earn some Dojos.



Our first lesson today is Maths

Our focus is multiplication and division.

Firstly, in your books, write down other words that mean the same as multiply. How many can you recall?

Now that you are in Y3, you need to know your 2,3,4,5,8,10 times tables. So today I want you to practise all of times tables and make sure that you can quickly recall facts. This will help you during this week's learning. Set your work out, recording the number sentences, into your books.

Go all the way up to 12 times a number.

$$1 \times 2 = 2$$

$$2 \times 2 = 4$$

$$3 \times 2 = 6$$

Next up today we are doing English.

Today we are going to be using fronted adverbials. Copy the fact box into your book.

- A fronted adverbial goes at the beginning of a sentence
- It describes the verb in the sentence
- It describes where, when and how
- A comma must come after a fronted adverbial.

What is Lent?

Lent is the period of 40 days (not including Sundays) that starts on Ash Wednesday and leads up to Easter, the most important festival in the Christian calendar.

The last week of Lent is called Holy Week.

During the 40 days of Lent, Christians remember the time when Jesus went into the desert to fast and pray before beginning his work for God.

During this time Jesus was tempted several times by Satan, but was able to resist.
