THE FLOOR IS LAVA



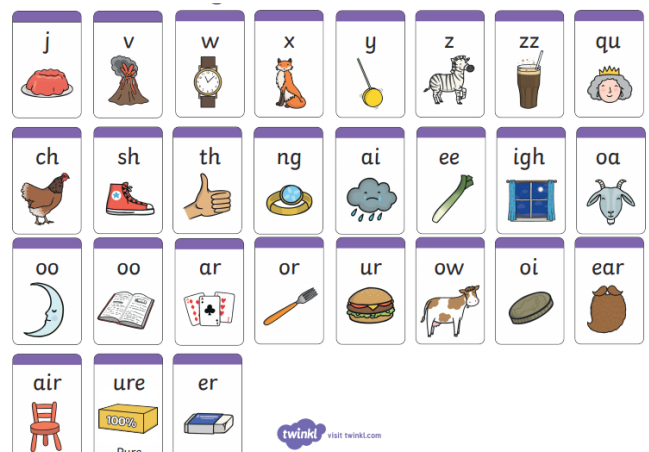
Have you ever played this game? Someone says the floor is lava and you have to get your feet off the floor.

Number

Today I want you to use the words heavy and light.

I want you to find two objects from around the house. Can you compare them. Which one is heavy, which one is light? Collect ten objects can you find the heaviest and lightest?



You could even make some weighing scales. All you need is a coat hanger, wool/string and some cups. Place an object in each cup if it tips towards the ground that object is heavier.



With your 10 objects you can put them in order from lightest to heaviest.
