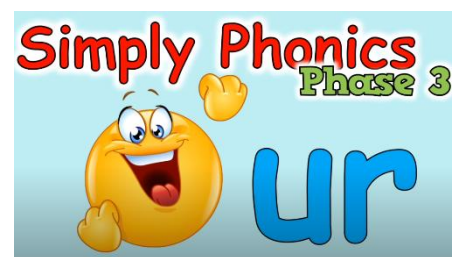


Phonics
