### Our first lesson today is maths

Yesterday, we recapped the value of each number. Today, I want you to partition each of the numbers (from yesterday) at least 4 different ways.

$$465 = 400 + 60 + 5$$

$$200 + 200 + 60 + 5$$

$$300 + 100 + 50 + 10 + 5$$

$$250 + 150 + 25 + 25 + 10 + 4 + 1$$

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Challenge - My number has four tens, eight thousands, nine ones and two hundreds. What is my number?

### Our next lesson is English.

Today, we are going to be focussing on using the correct punctuation when writing direct speech.

## Punctuation

There are two places where other forms of punctuation are needed when writing direct speech:

"What's the matter, Dina?" said Sid.

You need to end the speaking with:

- a comma
- a question mark, if it is a question.
- an exclamation mark, if it is an exclamation.

You will need to finish your sentence with a full stop after the reporting clause.

Examples of other punctuation in direct speech are:

"How exciting it is!" exclaimed Sarah.

"I don't know what to do," said Sayeed.

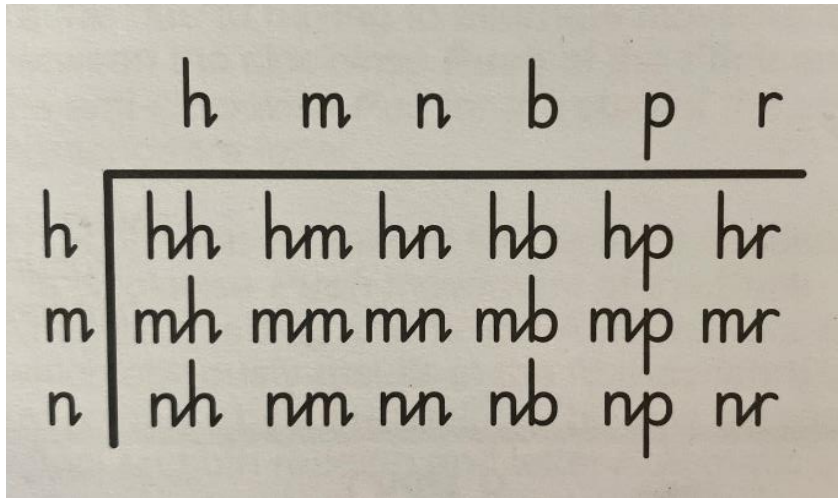
## Froggy Freeze Frame
