Monday 4<sup>th</sup> May

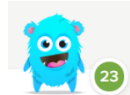
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Good morning everyone, I hope you had a lovely weekend. We were so close to getting 100 Dojo points last week. How many more points did we need? 🤔

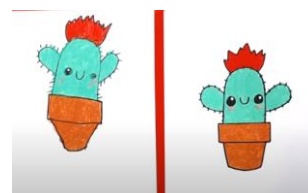
