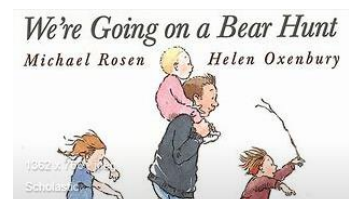

Go on a Bear Hunt

Have your very own bear hunt today. First you will need to make some binoculars. This time you will need 3 cardboard tubes (the third is for the casing which holds the tubes together) and some string.



Now, you are ready to go outside for a bear hunt adventure. Don't forget to look through the binoculars, say the bear hunt chant and join in with the actions.

We're going on a bear hunt.

Uh- Oh ...

What did you find first?

That's right long, wavy grass.



Note to parents

This activity can be done outdoors, in the garden or on one of your daily walks. It can even be done inside if the weather is poor.

Hide a bear for your child to find. You could even make a den as the bear's cave and use a paddling pool to splosh through the river. Or, just let your child pretend and have fun with their imagination. On the bear hunt encourage your child to say the chant and join in the actions. You could even make up some obstacles of your own.
