Story Time



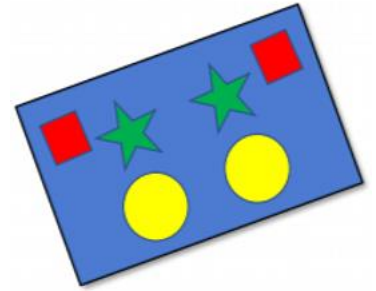
Enjoy this story called 'Pirate Pete'. You can pick different pictures and make up your own story.

The famous flag that you see on a pirate's ship is called 'The Jolly Rodger.' Can you make your own flag and give it a name?

Your challenge today is to make a flag which is symmetrical. That means it must be the same on both sides. Fold your paper down the middle and draw a faint pencil line to help you. If you put a square on one side you have to do it on the other.

Pirate Ship
