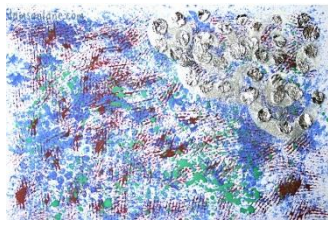


We're Going on a Bear Hunt Art

This scene was painted with a scourer.

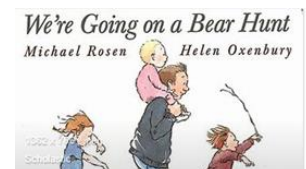


Soil, grass, sugar and watery paint were used in this collage.

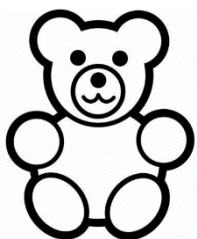

Draw a bear. Can you draw one wet nose, 2 big ears, 2 goggly eyes and 4 furry paws.

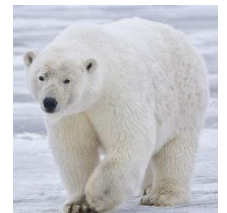


Challenge
